ART II SYLLABUS AND CLASS EXPECTATIONS

COURSE DESCRIPTION: Students will continue to build on knowledge and techniques learned in Art I with emphasis on technical mastery, personal expression, symbolism, and creative and expressive use of media. Class work includes reviewing elements and principles of design, drawing (portrait, still-life, perspective, figure, landscape), painting (watercolor, tempera, acrylic), pointillism, scratchboard, printmaking, 3-D sculpture, and pottery. Art history, art terminology, aesthetics, and critique methods will be studied using a class set of textbooks, PowerPoints and student research.

GRADING: 2/3 grade – artwork assignments, sketchbook assignments;
1/3 grade – textbook assignments, art history/scholastics, tests, and participation grade.

EVALUATION OF ART WORK: (A) Craftsmanship – skill, procedures, and purpose;
(B) Design quality – visual organization; (C) Expressiveness – relative to subject, idea, and theme;
(D) Originality - unique, imaginative.

FEE: \$20 per year to purchase: sketchbook, brushes, paints, canvas, printmaking supplies, drawing pencils, colored pencils, various media paper, pottery supplies, etc.

SEMESTER EXAMS: Two-part exam – written exam/artist statement and drawing exam.

ART CLASS EXPECTATIONS

Be kind and compassionate.

Do your share to keep supplies in their place and to clean up work areas.

Cooperate with classmates when you are sharing space, equipment, and supplies.

Be honest with yourself and others.

Show respect and be tolerant of differences.

Be self-disciplined and get work completed on time.

- Follow rules as stated in the Student Handbook.
- Sit in assigned seats and listen to instructions before beginning work each day.
- After instructions are given, students may talk QUIETLY while working.
- All students should be in the classroom when the bell rings, tardy policy will be enforced.
