PHOTOGRAPHY I SYLLABUS AND CLASS EXPECTATIONS

COURSE DESCRIPTION: The course goal of Photography I concentrates on many areas of photography: technical skills, creativity, composition, computer/digital imaging, and some alternative processes. Control of photo equipment and techniques, experimentation, problem solving, and portfolio development are critical to the course. YOU WILL ALSO BE USING A FEW APPS TO UPLOAD PHOTOS FOR GRADING AND EDITING PHOTOS, ALL TO BE DONE ON YOUR PHONES.

GRADING: 2/3 grade – photos taken in and outside of class, research assignments/presentations 1/3 grade – textbook assignments, art history, tests, and participation grades.

EVALUATION OF ART WORK: (A) Craftsmanship – skill, procedures, and purpose; (B) Design quality – visual organization; (C) Expressiveness – relative to subject, idea, and theme; (D) Originality - unique, imaginative.

FEE: \$5 per SEMESTER, this fee is used for the printing of photos for presentation, **EXAMS:** Semester exams will be in the form of written exam/artist statement and project exam.

ART CLASS EXPECTATIONS

Be kind and compassionate. Do your share to keep supplies in their place and to clean up work areas. Cooperate with classmates when you are sharing space, equipment, and supplies. Be honest with yourself and others. Show respect and be tolerant of differences. Be self-disciplined and get work completed on time.
